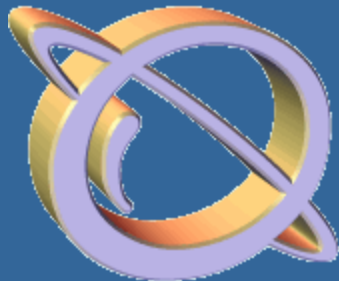
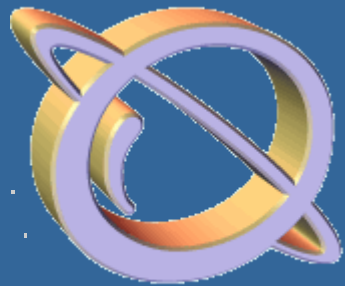

atone for our wrong doings and beg for healthy life! Compassionate**


Mother will make us drink her milk and we will be blessed.

happiness." Atharva-Veda 8/1/6



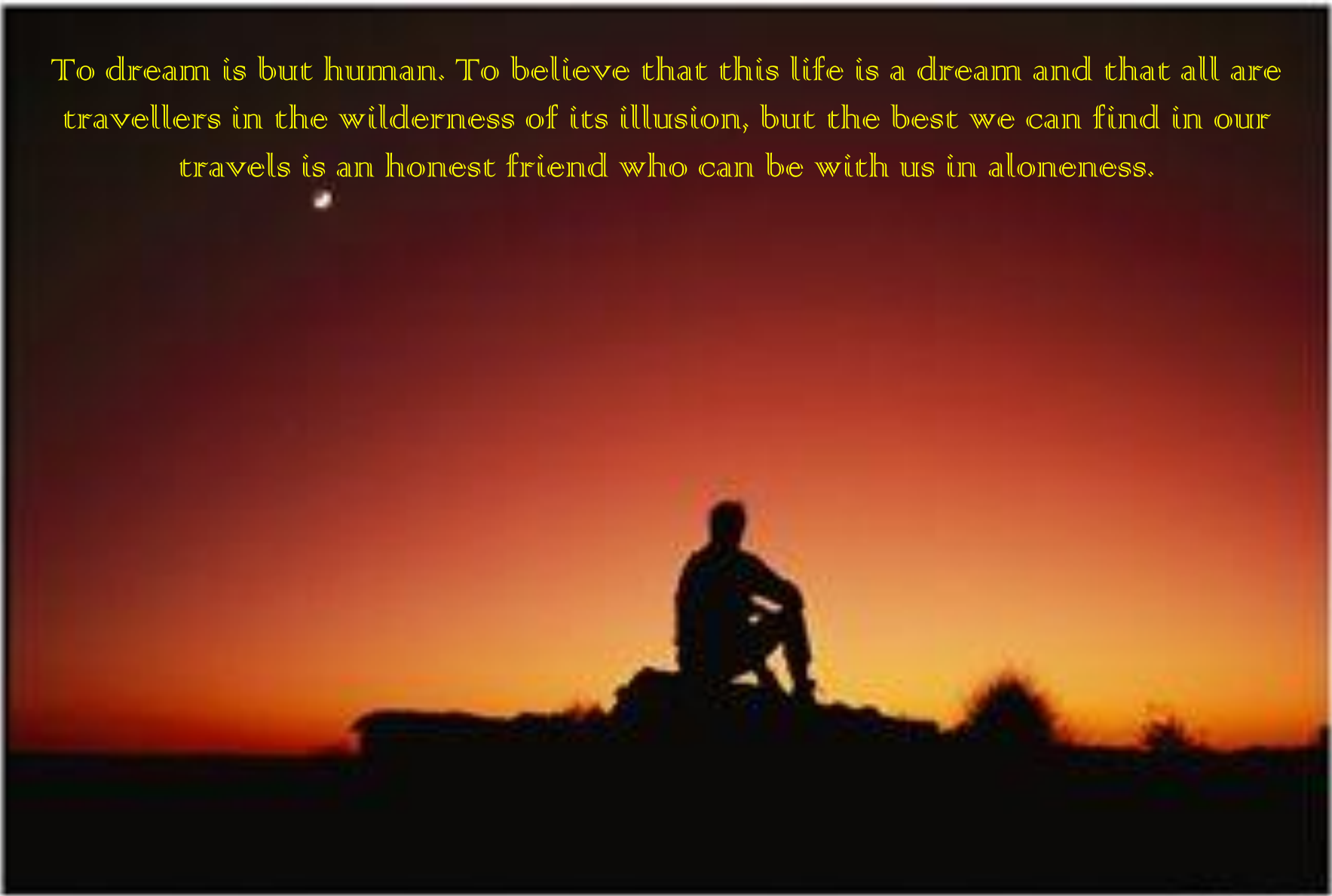

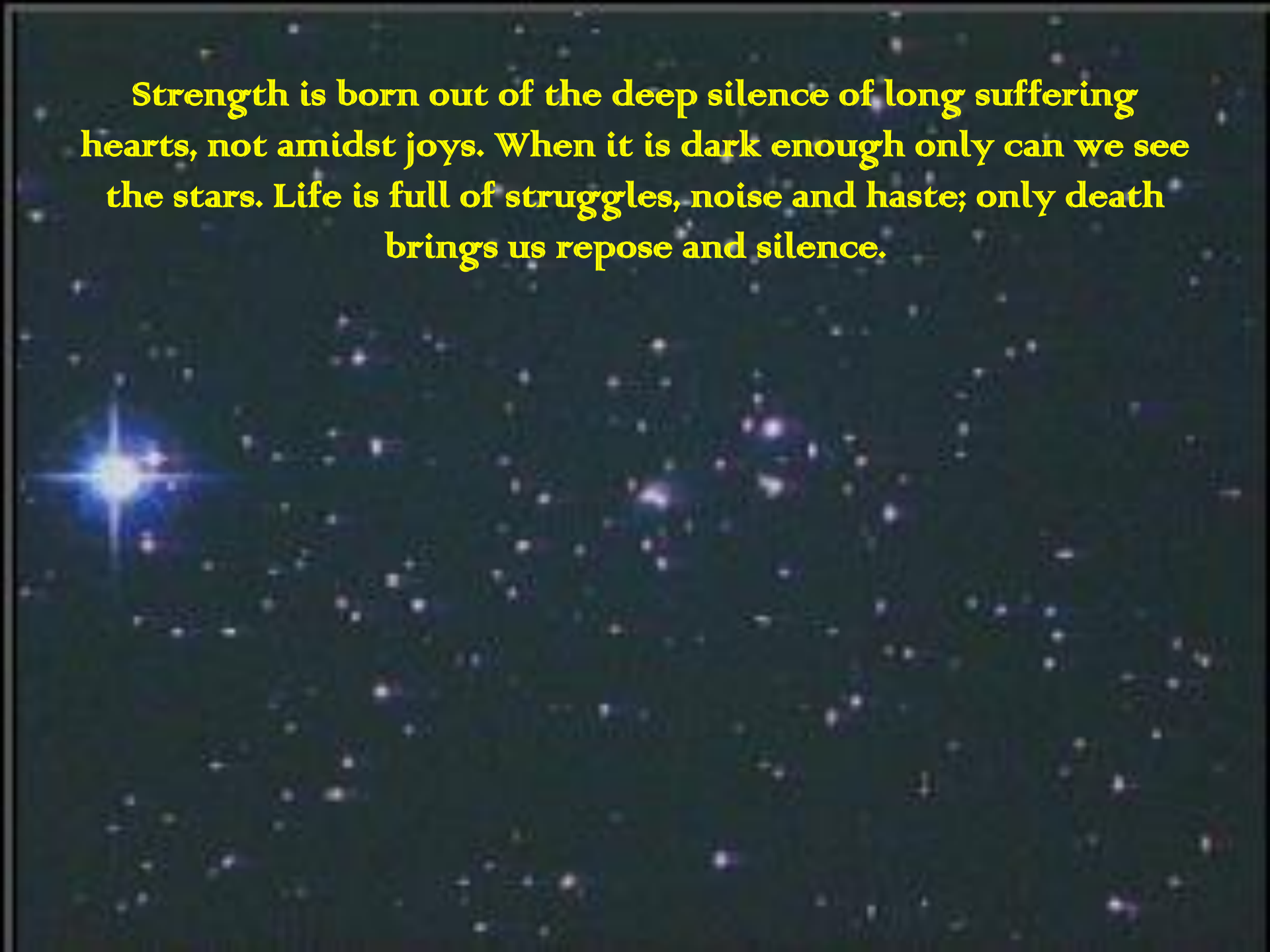
The Karmic Law
